Policy Document: Remedial Teaching; Advanced Learning and Experiential Learning

1. Remedial Teaching:

Remedial teaching is an essential component of St. Xavier's commitment to provide quality and inclusive education to all students. Our approach to remedial teaching is based on the following measures:

- i. Early identification of students who may require remedial support through classroom interactions, assignments, and mid semester examination results. This identification may be specifically initiated by the Head of Department or Class Mentor, and also by individual department teachers.
- ii. The College seeks to support these students with remedial classes in which individualized interactions with concerned teachers help to identify their specific needs and provide remedial measures including teaching, assignments and progress monitoring.
- iii. Remedial teaching is made available to students with various learning needs.
- iv. Special remedial classes have been introduced to cater to: a) students with disabilities, b) students who are weak in English as they may have studied English as a second language at the school level.
- v. Remedial classes are to be scheduled outside regular class hours.
- vi. Students seeking remedial classes may meet the appropriate Deans to register their requests.

2. Advanced Learning:

ix. Departments are encouraged to incorporate advanced topics and elective modules to meet the needs of advanced learners. These may or may not be part of the taught syllabus and may or may not be included for testing in examination.
